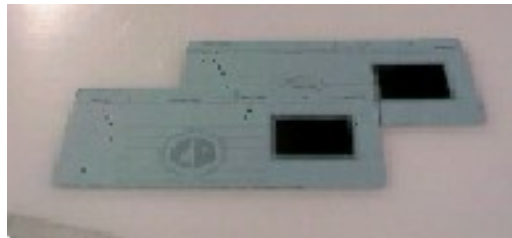
Already put your drawings on Aperture Cards?

- Save expensive space by eliminating drawing cabinets – typically 2,500 drawings (24"x26") can be stored on just one CD

Scanned information can be supplied in many formats including:

- TIFF – the most standard raster format
- PDF – a simple raster scan or can include OCR information that can be cut and pasted to other applications
- GIF – generally used for Internet applications
- JPEG – for color images
